"AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS."

1 Strike subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of section 1 and insert the 2 following in lieu thereof:

"(2) presents a certificate, in a form prescribed by the commissioner
pursuant to section 7 of this act, from a physician, physician assistant,
[or] advanced practice registered nurse or naturopath stating that in the
opinion of such physician, physician assistant,
[or] advanced practice
registered nurse or naturopath, such immunization is medically
contraindicated because of the physical condition of such child;"

9 Strike subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of section 3 and insert the 10 following in lieu thereof:

"(1) presents a certificate, in a form prescribed by the Commissioner
 of Public Health pursuant to section 7 of this act, from a physician, [or]

13 <u>a physician assistant</u>, an advanced practice registered nurse, or a

14 naturopath stating that in the opinion of such physician, [or] physician 15 assistant, advanced practice registered nurse or naturopath, such 16 immunization is medically contraindicated," 17 Strike subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of section 4 and insert the 18 following in lieu thereof: 19 "(1) presents a certificate, in a form prescribed by the Commissioner 20 of Public Health pursuant to section 7 of this act, from a physician, an 21 advanced practice registered nurse, [or] a physician assistant or a 22 naturopath stating that, in the opinion of such physician, advanced 23 practice registered nurse, [or] physician assistant or naturopath, such 24 vaccination is medically contraindicated because of the physical 25 condition of such student, or" 26 Strike subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of section 5 and insert the 27 following in lieu thereof: 28 "(1) presents a certificate, in a form prescribed by the Commissioner 29 of Public Health pursuant to section 7 of this act, signed by a physician, 30 a physician assistant, an advanced practice registered nurse or a naturopath stating that, in the opinion of such physician, physician 31 32 assistant, advanced practice registered nurse or naturopath, the 33 immunizations required pursuant to regulations adopted pursuant to 34 subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of this section are medically 35 contraindicated," 36 Strike subdivision (1) of subsection (g) of section 6 and insert the 37 following in lieu thereof: 38 "(1) presents a certificate, in a form prescribed by the Commissioner 39 of Public Health pursuant to section 7 of this act, signed by a physician, 40 a physician assistant, an advanced practice registered nurse or a 41 naturopath stating that, in the opinion of such physician, physician assistant, advanced practice registered nurse or naturopath, the 42

45 Strike section 7 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

46 "Sec. 7. (NEW) (Effective from passage) On or before October 1, 2021, 47 the Commissioner of Public Health shall develop and make available on 48 the Internet web site of the Department of Public Health a certificate for 49 use by a physician, physician assistant, advanced practice registered 50 nurse or naturopath stating that, in the opinion of such physician, 51 physician assistant, advanced practice registered nurse or naturopath, a 52 vaccination required by the general statutes is medicallv 53 contraindicated for a person because of the physical condition of such person. The certificate shall include (1) definitions of the terms 54 55 "contraindication" and "precaution", (2) a list of contraindications and 56 precautions recognized by the National Centers for Disease Control and 57 Prevention for each of the statutorily required vaccinations, from which 58 the physician, physician assistant, advanced practice registered nurse or 59 naturopath may select the relevant contraindication or precaution on 60 behalf of such person, (3) a section in which the physician, physician 61 assistant, advanced practice registered nurse or naturopath may record 62 a contraindication or precaution that is not recognized by the National 63 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, but in his or her discretion, 64 results in the vaccination being medically contraindicated, including, 65 but not limited to, any autoimmune disorder, family history of any 66 autoimmune disorder, family history of any reaction to a vaccination, 67 genetic predisposition to any reaction to a vaccination as determined 68 through genetic testing and a previous documented reaction of a person 69 that is correlated to a vaccination, (4) a section in which the physician, 70 physician assistant, advanced practice registered nurse or naturopath 71 may include a written explanation for the exemption from any 72 statutorily required vaccinations, (5) a section requiring the signature of 73 the physician, physician assistant, advanced practice registered nurse or 74 naturopath, (6) a requirement that the physician, physician assistant, 75 advanced practice registered nurse or naturopath attach such person's 76 most current immunization record, and (7) a synopsis of the grounds for 77 any order of quarantine or isolation pursuant to section 19a-131b of the 78 general statutes."

Strike subsection (a) of section 8 and insert the following in lieuthereof"

81 "(a) There is established an Advisory Committee on Medically 82 Contraindicated Vaccinations within the Department of Public Health 83 for the purpose of advising the Commissioner of Public Health on issues 84 concerning exemptions from state or federal requirements for 85 vaccinations that result from a physician, physician assistant, advanced 86 practice registered nurse or naturopath stating that a vaccination is 87 medically contraindicated for a person due to the medical condition of such person. Said advisory committee shall not be responsible for 88 89 confirming or denying any determination by a physician, physician 90 assistant, advanced practice registered nurse or naturopath that a 91 vaccination is medically contraindicated for a specific individual. In 92 order to carry out its duties, the advisory committee shall (1) have access 93 to the childhood immunization registry established by the department 94 pursuant to section 19a-7h of the general statutes, (2) evaluate the 95 process used by the department in collecting data concerning 96 exemptions resulting from а vaccination being medically 97 contraindicated and whether the department should have any oversight 98 over such exemptions, (3) examine whether enrollment of an 99 unvaccinated child into a program operated by a public or nonpublic 100 school, institution of higher education, child care center or group child 101 care home should be conditioned upon the child meeting certain 102 criteria, (4) calculate the ratio of school nurses to students in each public 103 and nonpublic school in the state and the funding issues surrounding 104 such ratio, (5) assess whether immunizations should be required more 105 frequently than prior to enrollment into a program operated by a public 106 or nonpublic school and prior to entering seventh grade, and (6) 107 determine whether (A) there are any discrepancies in the issuance of 108 certificates stating that a vaccine is medically contraindicated, and (B) to 109 recommend continuing education of physicians, physician assistants, 110 advanced practice registered nurses or naturopaths in vaccine 111 contraindications and precautions. All information obtained by the 112 advisory committee from such registry shall be confidential pursuant to

113 section 19a-25 of the general statutes, as amended by this act."
