## "AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective from passage) The Department of Public 4 Health shall collect compliance data concerning the immunization 5 requirements of this act and disaggregate such data to determine the compliance rate for each vaccine required pursuant to the provisions 6 7 sections 10-204a, 10-155, 10a-155b, 19a-79 and 19a-87b of the general 8 statutes, as amended by this act, for children and students who have a 9 religious exemption from immunization requirements. Not later than 10 January 1, 2022, and annually thereafter, the Commissioner of Public 11 health shall report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of 12 the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General 13 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to public health 14 regarding the data collected pursuant to this section."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
