## "AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS."

- Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following in lieu thereof:
- "Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 10-204a of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):
  - (b) The definitions of adequate immunization shall reflect the schedule for active immunization adopted pursuant to section 19a-7f and be established by regulation adopted in accordance with the provisions of chapter 54 by the Commissioner of Public Health, who shall also be responsible for providing procedures under which [said] such boards and [said] similar governing bodies shall collect and report immunization data on each child to the Department of Public Health for (1) compilation and analysis by [said] the department, and (2) release by the department of annual immunization rates, the rate of exemptions
