"AN ACT CONCERNING EDUCATION MANDATE RELIEF AND OTHER TECHNICAL AND ASSORTED REVISIONS AND ADDITIONS TO THE EDUCATION AND EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION STATUTES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (e) of section 10-220 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1,*
5 *2023*):

6 (e) (1) Each local and regional board of education shall establish a
7 school district curriculum committee. The committee shall recommend,
8 develop, review and approve all curriculum for the local or regional

9 school district.

10 (2) For the school year commencing July 1, 2023, and each school year
 11 thereafter, each local and regional board of education shall make
 12 available on the board's and each individual school's Internet web site
 13 the (A) syllabus and curriculum, including any accompanying materials
 14 related to implementing such curriculum, for each course offered by
 15 such board or classroom at the school, and (B) the contact information
 16 for a representative of the school district curriculum committee,
 17 described in subdivision (1) of this subsection, who is responsible for
 18 making available to the parent or guardian of a student enrolled in a
 19 school under the jurisdiction of such board who requests, any
 20 curriculum materials that are unable to be published on such Internet
 21 web site."
