## "AN ACT CONCERNING JUVENILE JUSTICE."

- 1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
- 2 internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. Section 53a-110 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2023*):
- 5 It shall be an affirmative defense to prosecution for criminal trespass
- 6 that: (1) The [building involved in the offense was abandoned; or (2) the]
- 7 premises, at the time of the entry or remaining, were open to the public
- 8 and the actor complied with all lawful conditions imposed on access to
- 9 or remaining in the premises; or [(3)] (2) the actor reasonably believed
- 10 that the owner of the premises, or a person empowered to license access
- 11 thereto, would have licensed him to enter or remain, or that he was
- 12 licensed to do so. "
