"AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONNECTICUT CLEAN AIR ACT."

- After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. Section 2-15 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):
- 5 [The] (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the
- 6 Comptroller shall draw [his] <u>an</u> order on the Treasurer for a
- 7 transportation allowance for each member or member-elect of the
- 8 General Assembly, and the Treasurer shall pay to such member as an
- 9 allowance for transportation, such rate per mile as shall from time to
- 10 time be determined by the Joint Committee on Legislative Management.
- The allowance shall be paid for each mile on each day that such member
- is required to travel: (1) From [his] <u>such member's</u> home to the State
- 13 Capitol and return therefrom to attend a session of the General
- 14 Assembly or a meeting of a committee of the General Assembly or a

15 public hearing held by any such committee or for other official

- legislative business, or (2) from [his] <u>such member's</u> home to such other
- 17 location within the state at which any such committee meeting or public
- 18 hearing is held and return therefrom.
- 19 <u>(b) No member or member-elect of the General Assembly may</u>
- 20 receive a transportation allowance for traveling on a day when such
- 21 <u>member or member-elect uses an electric vehicle charging station, as</u>
- 22 <u>defined in section 16-19f, located on the building, grounds or related</u>
- 23 facilities of the State Capitol or the Legislative Office Building."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Sec. 501 <i>from passage</i> 2-15
