"AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH AND WELLNESS FOR CONNECTICUT RESIDENTS."

- After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and internal references accordingly:
- 3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2023) (a) As used in this section,
- 4 "intranasal glucagon" means a class of medications referred to as
- 5 glycogenolytic agents that cause the liver to reduce stored sugar to the
- 6 blood and are intended for the treatment of severe hypoglycemia in
- 7 persons with diabetes who are treated with insulin.
- 8 (b) Not later than October 1, 2023, each municipality shall amend its
- 9 local emergency medical services plan, as described in section 19a-181b
- 10 of the general statutes, to ensure that at least one emergency medical
- services provider, as defined in the regulations of Connecticut state
- 12 agencies pertaining to emergency medical services, who is likely to be
- 13 the first person to arrive on the scene of a medical emergency in the

14 municipality, including, but not limited to, emergency medical services

- personnel, as defined in section 20-206jj of the general statutes, or a
- 16 resident state trooper, is equipped with intranasal glucagon and such
- person has received training, approved by the Commissioner of Public
- 18 Health, in the administration of intranasal glucagon."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
