- 2 Strike section 3 in its entirety
- 3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
- 4 internal references accordingly:
- 5 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (from passage) (a) On and after January 1, 2024, each
- 6 distributor and dealer shall undertake efforts to educate consumers of
- 7 the ten cent redemption value for beverage containers.
- 8 (b) No person shall redeem more than two hundred forty beverage
- 9 containers at any one time at a dealer's reverse vending machine.

- "consumer", "beverage container" and "reverse vending machine" each
- 12 have the same meaning as provided in section 22a-243 of the general
