- 3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective January 1, 2022) (a) The Insurance
- 4 Commissioner shall determine the total amount of credits provided
- 5 under sections 2, 4 and 5 of this act for calendar year 2022.
- 6 (b) Not later than February 1, 2023, the Insurance Commissioner shall
- 7 submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
- 8 general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General
- 9 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to insurance. Such
- 10 report shall include the amount determined by the commissioner
- 11 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section."
