4 "(d) A peace officer shall not be required to request emergency
5 medical services when such officer (1) has made a reasonable
6 determination that the person is not (A) experiencing an emergency
7 medical condition, or (B) medically unstable, and (2) knows that such
8 person has been seen by a medical professional within the previous
9 twenty-four hours and was released from such medical professional's
10 care after a determination that such person was not (A) experiencing an
11 emergency medical condition, or (B) medically unstable."
