### ***Explanation***

The bill makes a variety of campaign finance reforms concerning attribution requirements, transfers between campaign committees and creates a CPI adjustment for aggregate contributions, individual contributions, grants, and organizational contributions resulting in no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities. The amendment also shifts the beginning date keeping current practice in place for the November 2024 elections.

House "A" strikes the underlying bill and results in the fiscal impact described above.

House "B" aligns individual contribution amount for non-Citizens Election Program (CEP) House of Representative candidates with the individual contribution requirements for House CEP candidates and results in no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
