The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

It requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) to conduct a study of waste characterization and composition and analyze the impact on solid waste management. It requires DEEP to report on its findings by January 1, 2024, to the legislature.

This has no fiscal impact since DEEP has expertise for the study.
