Potential Revenue Loss

The amendment removes the Department of Consumer Protection's ability to charge a fee of up to \$15 when an individual convicted of a criminal offense request to know if it disqualifies them from obtaining a certificate or license resulting in a potential revenue loss to the state to the extent these fees are assessed.
