No Fiscal Impact

The amendment requires the registrars of voters of each town to compile a report of the number of persons applying for election day registration and forward them to the Secretary of the State who shall aggregate all into a single report. This has no fiscal impact.

The amendment requires the Secretary of the State to develop a process by which registrars of voters and other elections officials serving at designated election day registration locations shall confirm that persons applying to register on election day are not registered to vote in any other state and have not already voted in such other state on such election day.
