### Explanation

The amendment eliminates the bill's limitations regarding the types of projects that the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) can execute independently and allows DEEP to carry out additional projects independently. The amendment also changes when inflation is first applied to the expenditure thresholds revised by the bill, from July 1, 2024 to July 1, 2025. No fiscal impact is anticipated from the amendment as no changes in project costs are expected.
