# Municipal Impact: None

## Explanation

The bill makes a variety of changes around campaign donation requirements to qualify for the Citizen's Election Program (CEP) and results in the minimal revenue loss described below.

The bill changes existing requirements for the return of nonqualifying campaign contributions, and results in a minimal revenue loss within the Citizens Election Fund (CEF). The impact of the revenue loss will depend on the number of contributions that did not qualify and will have to be returned.

#### The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to inflation.
