The amendment strikes sections 4 and 5 of the underlying bill. This eliminates provisions that allow municipalities to adopt an ordinance to use municipal violation enforcement systems to enforce and monitor the illegal passing of a school bus and send associated citations by first class mail.

This eliminates any potential cost to municipalities for installing violation enforcement systems, entering into an agreement with a private vendor, or sending violations by first class mail. The amendment also eliminates any potential revenue gain associated with issuing a fine associated with this municipal ordinance.
