Potential Cost

The amendment requires the Insurance Department (DOI) to determine the aggregate amount of credits provided in accordance with the bill in 2022 and to submit a report on it by February 1, 2023. The Insurance Department does not currently collect this information and it is not known to what extent carriers would submit it voluntarily. To the extent that DOI must contract with a third-party for either data collection or estimation, in lieu of receiving the data from carriers and pharmacy benefit managers, there is a potential cost to DOI in FY 23.
