## **Explanation**

The amendment expands the number of law enforcement agencies eligible for funding under the bill's pilot program to include all agencies serving municipalities with populations greater than 50,000 (changed from 100,000), resulting in a cost to the state and a revenue gain to affected municipalities, depending on the amount of funding provided by the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection.
