## AN ACT STUDYING PAID SICK DAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) The Labor Commissioner shall
- 2 conduct a study of the paid sick days statutes in the state. Not later than
- 3 January 1, 2025, the commissioner shall report the results of the study,
- 4 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
- 5 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
- 6 cognizance of matters relating to labor and public employees. Such
- 7 report may include the commissioner's recommendations for legislation
- 8 regarding the paid sick days statutes in the state.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following		
sections:
