AN ACT EXPANDING ELIGIBILITY FOR THE APPRENTICESHIP TAX CREDIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-217g of the general statutes be amended to expand
- 2 eligibility for the apprenticeship tax credit by reducing, from four
- 3 thousand to two thousand, the minimum number of hours required for
- 4 a qualified apprenticeship training program.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand eligibility for the apprenticeship tax credit by reducing the minimum number of hours required for a qualified apprenticeship training program.

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
