AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CREDIT AGAINST THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX FOR VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS AND VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE MEMBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to establish, for a volunteer firefighter or volunteer ambulance member, a credit against the personal income tax of five hundred dollars for a person filing as an unmarried individual and one thousand dollars for married individuals
