AN ACT REQUIRING THE REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES TO FUND THE MAINTENANCE OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE TRAILS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the registration of
- 2 any all-terrain vehicle that is not solely operated on the property of the
- 3 vehicle's owner and that such annual registration fee be thirty dollars.
- 4 Additionally, the revenue from such registration fees would be
- 5 required to be used by the Department of Energy and Environmental
- 6 Protection to maintain all-terrain vehicle trails on state property.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide a funding source for the creation and maintenance of allterrain vehicle trails on state property.
