AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CHILD CARE CENTER IN GROTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 thirteen million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the
- 5 Office of Early Childhood for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to
- 6 Thames Valley Council for Community Action for the construction of a
- 7 child care center in Groton.
