AN ACT CONCERNING GRADUAL DISBURSEMENT OF CERTAIN GRANTS UNDER THE CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 157 of the general statutes be amended to require that 2 the State Elections Enforcement Commission, for any candidate whose 3 application for a grant from the Citizens' Election Fund for the general 4 election campaign has been approved, disburse to such candidate one-5 third of the amount of such grant each month for three months upon 6 approval of such application, except that (1) one-half of the amount of 7 such grant shall be disbursed each month for two months if such 8 application is approved in October, and (2) the full amount of such 9 grant shall be disbursed if such application is approved in November.

Statement of Purpose:

To gradually disburse certain grants to candidates under the Citizens' Election Program.
