AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE TO CONSTRUCT A CHILD GUIDANCE CLINIC IN STONINGTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 three hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by
- 5 the Department of Education for the purpose of providing a grant-in-
- 6 aid to the Child and Family Agency of Southeastern Connecticut, Inc. to
- 7 construct a child guidance clinic in the town of Stonington.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize funding for the construction of a child guidance clinic in the town of Stonington, in order to promote affordable child care, afterschool care and school-based medical care.
