**AN ACT REQUIRING REDEMPTION CENTERS AND DEALERS THAT
HOST REVERSE VENDING MACHINES TO PROVIDE CERTAIN
INFORMATION TO CONSUMERS WHEN REVERSE VENDING
MACHINES ARE OUT OF ORDER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the owner or
- 2 operator of redemption centers and dealers that host reverse vending
- 3 machines in the state to post information for consumers indicating the
- 4 nearest other redemption center or dealer when such redemption
- 5 center's or dealer's reverse vending machines are out of order.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide necessary consumer information when reverse vending machines are inoperable.
