AN ACT CONCERNING THE THEFT OF WASTE VEGETABLE OIL OR ANIMAL FATS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 53a-125 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2020*):
- 3 (a) A person is guilty of larceny in the fourth degree when he commits
- 4 larceny as defined in section 53a-119 and: (1) The property consists of
- 5 <u>waste vegetable oil or animal fats; or (2)</u> the value of the property or
- 6 service exceeds one thousand dollars.
- 7 (b) For purposes of this section, "waste vegetable oil or animal fats"
- 8 means used vegetable oil or animal fats stored by a school, restaurant,
- 9 <u>institutional cafeteria or other institution or business for the purpose of</u>
- 10 collection and recycling of such oil or fats, including the conversion of
- such oil or fats into a biodiesel blend, as defined in section 16a-21b.
- [(b)] (c) Larceny in the fourth degree is a class A misdemeanor.
