AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO COUNSEL IN CERTAIN SUMMARY PROCESS PROCEEDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 832 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 counsel to any person who has been named as defendant in a summary
- 3 process proceeding who faces dispossession from a rental premises as a
- 4 result of being negatively affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that any tenant negatively affected by the COVID-19 pandemic has access to legal counsel in a summary process proceeding.
