AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF CHILDREN BY RELATIVE CAREGIVERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapters 803 and 815t of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 provide that in any proceeding involving the potential adoption of a
- 3 minor child by a prospective adoptive parent who is a relative of the
- 4 child, the Department of Children and Families may not present
- 5 evidence of abuse, neglect or drug use, which is alleged to have been
- 6 committed by such prospective adoptive more than ten years prior to
- 7 the date of the proceeding, except evidence of sexual abuse alleged to
- 8 have been committed by such prospective adoptive parent more than
- 9 ten years prior to the date proceeding, may be presented by the
- 10 department.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote the adoption of children by relative caregivers.
