AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR RENOVATIONS TO THE BARBELL CLUB IN NEW HAVEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate 4 five million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the 5 Department of Economic and Community Development for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the city of New Haven to renovate the 6 7 Barbell Club building to serve as a community and youth center for 8 after-school programs.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize bonds of the state for renovations to the Barbell Club building in New Haven to serve as a community and youth center.
