**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A WORKING GROUP TO STUDY THE
FEASIBILITY OF ALLOWING VIDEO CAMERAS IN THE ROOMS OF
NURSING HOME RESIDENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17a of the general statutes be amended to establish a
- 2 working group under the auspices of the Office of the Long-Term Care
- 3 Ombudsman to study the feasibility of allowing video cameras in the
- 4 rooms of nursing home residents to promote resident well-being,
- 5 including by enhancing communication with family members.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a working group to discuss the feasibility of allowing video cameras in the rooms of nursing home residents.
