## AN ACT ELIMINATING THE PASSPORT TO THE PARKS VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEE FOR PERSONS OVER SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE AND FOR VETERANS AND REQUIRING PAYMENT OF SUCH FEE ON ONLY ONE CAR OWNED BY A PERSON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to exempt persons who are
- 2 sixty-five years of age or older or who are veterans from the requirement
- 3 to pay the Passport to the Parks vehicle registration fee and to require
- 4 any person who owns more than one vehicle to only have to pay such
- 5 fee on one of the vehicles owned by such person.

## Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate or reduce the Passport to the Parks vehicle registration fee for certain citizens of the state.
