AN ACT EXEMPTING THE REGISTRATION OF MULTIPLE VEHICLES BY ONE OWNER FROM PAYMENT OF THE PASSPORT TO THE PARKS REGISTRATION FEE ON EACH VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to only require the payment of
- 2 one Passport to the Parks motor vehicle registration fee if a person owns
- 3 and registers more than one car.

Statement of Purpose:

To require payment of the Passport to the Parks motor vehicle registration fee on only one of the cars owned by a person when such person registers more than one car.
