**AN ACT EXEMPTING THE REGISTRATION OF MULTIPLE VEHICLES
BY ONE OWNER FROM PAYMENT OF THE PASSPORT TO THE
PARKS REGISTRATION FEE ON EACH VEHICLE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to only require the payment of
- 2 one Passport to the Parks motor vehicle registration fee if a person owns
- 3 and registers more than one car.

Statement of Purpose:

To require payment of the Passport to the Parks motor vehicle registration fee on only one of the cars owned by a person when such person registers more than one car.
