AN ACT REQUIRING HOSPITALS TO HAVE AN URGENT CARE CENTER LOCATED NEAR THEIR EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT TO CARE FOR PATIENTS WHO DO NOT REQUIRE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to require each hospital to have an urgent care center that (1) may be staffed by hospital employees or independent health care providers, and (2) shall be located near its emergency department, to care for patients who do not require emergency medical services.

Statement of Purpose:

To give patients seeking urgent care a more affordable option than the services provided at emergency departments.
