## AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR GRANTS-IN-AID TO CERTAIN NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 two hundred fifty million dollars, provided fifty million dollars of said
- 5 authorization shall be available in each of the next five years, the
- 6 proceeds of which shall be used by the Department of Housing to
- 7 provide grants-in-aid to nonprofit organizations that serve persons
- 8 experiencing homelessness to develop affordable housing projects in
- 9 collaboration with local public housing authorities.

## Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for certain nonprofits to develop affordable housing projects in collaboration with local public housing authorities.
