AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAMS FOR CERTAIN YOUTHS DISCONNECTED FROM EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE TRAINING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate ____ dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the Office of Policy and Management for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to identify youths who are disconnected from education and workforce training and at risk for criminal behavior and direct them to early intervention programs.

To provide funding to identify youths who are disconnected from education and workforce training and at risk for criminal behavior and direct them to early intervention programs.
