## AN ACT CONCERNING THE PENALTY FOR SPOOFING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 16-256e of the general statutes be amended to make any
- 2 person using a device which transmits an unsolicited recorded
- 3 telephone message for any commercial, business or advertising
- 4 purpose to any telephone customer in the state and which continues
- 5 the call and message after the customer hangs up the receiver while
- 6 intentionally using a blocking device or service to circumvent a
- 7 telephone customer's use of a caller identification service or device
- 8 guilty of a class E felony.

## Statement of Purpose:

To change the penalty for spoofing to a class E felony.
