AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CONSIDERATIONS RELATED TO LIVESTOCK PROCESSING FACILITIES IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Economic and 2 Community Development shall conduct a study of economic 3 development benefits or issues relating to livestock processing facilities 4 in the state. Not later than January 1, 2023, the commissioner shall 5 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general 6 statutes, regarding the results of such study to the joint standing 7 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters 8 relating to commerce.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	from passage	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Economic and Community Development to study the economic benefits or issues relating to livestock processing facilities in the state.
