Public Act No. 24-87

AN ACT REQUIRING DISCLOSURE OF SCHOLARSHIP DISPLACEMENT POLICIES AT INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2024*) (a) As used in this section, "scholarship displacement" means the reduction of the amount of financial aid offered to a current or prospective student as a result of such student receiving a scholarship.

(b) Each institution of higher education in the state shall disclose such institution's policy on scholarship displacement (1) in the initial financial aid package offered to each prospective or current student, and (2) not later than January 1, 2025, in a report submitted, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to higher education and employment advancement.
