**AN ACT REQUIRING CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION IN
RECOGNIZING SYMPTOMS OF ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND
DEMENTIA.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require physicians,
- 2 advanced practice registered nurses, physician assistants, registered
- 3 nurses and practical nurses to receive continuing medical education in
- 4 the signs and symptoms of Alzheimer's disease and dementia.

Statement of Purpose:

To require physicians, advanced practice registered nurses, physician assistants and nurses to be trained in recognizing symptoms of Alzheimer's disease and dementia.
