AN ACT ELIMINATING DOUBLE REGISTRATION BY FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 19a-36i of the general statutes be amended to eliminate
- 2 the requirement that a food establishment provide the Department of
- 3 Public Health with (1) proof of registration with the director of health
- 4 of the town, city or borough in which such food establishment is
- 5 located, and (2) a written application for a permit.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the requirement that food establishments register with the Department of Public Health when such establishments are also required to register with their director of health.
