## AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION TO CONDUCT A STUDY AND SUBMIT A REPORT CONCERNING KRATOM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 21a of the general statutes be amended to require the Department of Consumer Protection, within available resources, to (1) study the effects of kratom on the health of adults and children, and (2) submit, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters pertaining to consumer protection, a report containing (A) the results of such study, and (B) the department's recommendations concerning kratom regulation.

## Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Consumer Protection to study the health effects of kratom and submit a report containing the results of such study and the department's recommendations concerning kratom regulation.
