AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE IMPACT OF PERMITTING RESPONDERS WHO ARE NOT PRIMARY SERVICE AREA RESPONDERS TO RESPOND TO A PRIMARY SERVICE AREA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2020*) (a) As used in this section:
- 2 (1) "Emergency medical responder" means an individual who is 3 certified pursuant to chapter 384d of the general statutes;
- 4 (2) "Primary service area responder" means an emergency medical service organization who is designated to respond to a victim of sudden
- 6 illness or injury in a primary service area; and
- 7 (3) "Primary service area" means a specific geographic area to which 8 one designated emergency medical service organization is assigned for
- 9 each category of emergency medical response services.
- 10 (b) The Department of Public Health shall study the impact of
- 11 allowing an emergency medical responder who is not a primary service
- 12 area responder to respond to a primary service area to which the

- 13 emergency medical responder is not assigned. Not later than January 1,
- 14 2021, the Commissioner of Public Health shall report, in accordance
- with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint
- 16 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 17 matters relating to public health regarding the outcome of the study.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To require a study of the impact of allowing nonprimary service area responders to respond to a primary service area.
