## AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF THREE-YEAR DOG LICENSES BY TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize towns to issue
- 2 dog licenses that are renewable after three years.

## Statement of Purpose:

To allow towns to issue dog licenses every three years.
