AN ACT CONCERNING INSTALLERS OF RESIDENTIAL VERTICAL PLATFORM LIFTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 20-340f of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):
- 3 (a) Not later than December 31, 2016, the Commissioner of Consumer
- 4 Protection, after consultation with the Elevator Installation, Repair and
- 5 Maintenance Board established pursuant to section 20-331, shall adopt
- 6 regulations, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 54, to establish
- 7 a residential stair lift technician's license. Not later than December 31,
- 8 2022, the commissioner, after consultation with the Elevator Installation,
- 9 Repair and Maintenance Board, shall amend such regulations to
- 10 <u>establish a residential vertical platform lift technician's license.</u> Such
- 11 regulations shall include, but need not be limited to, the amount and
- 12 type of experience, training, continuing education and examination
- 13 requirements, if any, for a person to obtain and renew [such] a
- 14 residential stair lift technician's license and a residential vertical
- 15 platform lift technician's license.

- 16 (b) The initial fee for a residential stair lift technician's license <u>or a</u>
 17 <u>residential vertical platform lift technician's license</u> shall be one hundred
 18 fifty dollars and the renewal fee for <u>each</u> such license shall be seventy19 five dollars. Licenses shall be valid for a period of one year from the date
 20 of issuance.
- 22 (c) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the holder of an occupational 22 license issued pursuant to this chapter that allows the installation and 23 repair of residential stair lifts <u>or residential vertical platform lifts</u> from 24 performing such work. A holder of such occupational license shall not 25 be required to obtain a residential stair lift technician's license <u>or a</u> 26 residential vertical platform lift technician's license.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
