AN ACT CONCERNING THE SUSPENSION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE OF ANY PERSON WHO CAUSES SIGNIFICANT PROPERTY DAMAGE RESULTING FROM THE USE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 14 of the general statutes be amended to require the

2 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to suspend the motor vehicle

3 operator's license of any person for (1) two years if such person caused

4 property damage resulting from or caused by the use or operation of a

5 motor vehicle and the amount of such property damages is not less than

6 ten thousand dollars, but not more than twenty thousand dollars, (2)

four years if the amount of such property damage is more than twenty

8 thousand dollars, but not more than thirty thousand dollars, and (3) six

9 years if the amount of such property damage is more than thirty

10 thousand dollars.
