AN ACT WAIVING OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING FEES FOR CERTAIN VETERANS AND FAMILY MEMBERS OF ACTIVE MILITARY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to waive occupational licensing
- 2 fees for (1) any veteran whose training and experience while serving in
- 3 the armed forces is deemed sufficient to demonstrate the requisite skill
- 4 for licensure, and (2) in the case of a person currently serving in the
- 5 armed forces who received military orders to report to the state, any
- 6 family member thereof who prior to such orders was licensed or
- 7 certified to practice a certain occupation at a military installation.

Statement of Purpose:

To waive occupational licensing fees for certain veterans and family members of active military.
