AN ACT CONCERNING THE TEACHER CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ADJUNCT COLLEGE PROFESSORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That part I of chapter 166 of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 reduce the requirements for and waive the fee relating to the issuance
- 3 of a teaching certificate for an individual who possess a doctorate degree
- 4 or is an adjunct professor at a college or university, and to permit such
- 5 individual to teach in a public high school in the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To alleviate the teacher shortage in the state by making adjunct college professors eligible to teach in public high schools.
